Would you recommend any of our courses to your friends? Why?

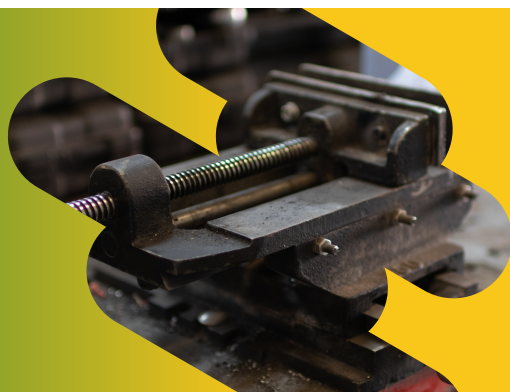
Yes, definitely I would, it's a great hobby, great fun and we've made other friends along the way
