"The Hunslet Club Vocational Development Programme aims to engage young people aged 14-16 through practical hands-on learning, in a safe and welcoming environment. The supportive environment looks to improve the young people's skills and chances of progressing into a positive destination, being that re-engagement into their home provider, progressing into further education, an apprenticeship / traineeship or gaining employment. We do not only provide the skills and knowledge required to succeed in an educational setting, we also teach the social and emotional skills needed to flourish in the workplace. Working with challenging young people to help them get back on track and planting seeds of values to grow and be used later on in life."

The Hunslet Club is a not-for-profit youth organisation and registered charity with over 3,500 members. We strive to ensure young people in and around Leeds can reach their full potential, despite financial circumstances. Our alternative education scheme is a daytime education programme that leads to accredited qualifications in eleven different subjects.

This alternative education programme provides young people aged 14 – 16, who are at risk of low achievement in school or are disadvantaged by the school environment with a new way to learn. Students have the opportunity to study vocational courses, that interest them, in small class sizes with unparalleled support from their tutors.



These vocational courses are designed for young people who may struggle with a traditional classroom setting. We aim to deliver a quality learning experience in an environment that is both welcoming and safe, where young people can have a hands-on experience with learning, with one-to-one help from vocational tutors.

The assessment team are professionally competent and qualified in their subject areas and have a relevant teaching qualification. They are assisted by a team of support workers, administrators and management staff.

We are a registered learning centre with Pearson and NOCN. We are also an approved provider of Education Leeds. The Hunslet Club is committed to developing its Vocational Development Programme and offering opportunities for all young people irrespective of educational or social circumstances.

Every young person should have the opportunity to reach their full potential, and these courses are just one way we hope to broaden their horizons and progress to a positive destination.

#### BTEC Level 1 / 2 Award in Home Cooking Skills

The Pearson BTEC Level 1 / 2 Award in Home Cooking Skills gives young people the knowledge, skills, and confidence to enjoy cooking meals at home. This course aims to provide young people with basic cooking skills, the ability to follow recipes, learn how to use kitchen equipment safely and reflect on the knowledge surrounding different dishes.

Young people will also develop their understanding of sourcing food, nutrition, hygiene and food safety, where relevant through the course.

#### Level 1 Introductory Award / Certificate in Construction
